Jpava

iis a statutory town in the Opava district in the Moravian-Silesian Region. It islocated in the Opava Hills on the Opava River and has approximately 55,000 inhabitants, making it the third largestcity in the Moravian-Silesian Region after Ostrava and Havířov. It was originally the center of the Principality of Opava and between 1742 and 1928 the capital of the Austrian, or of Czech Silesia with regional authorities.

Silesian Museum


Oldest and third largest museum in CR

Leopold Bauer

September 1, 1872 Krnov - October 7, 1938 Vienna Architect, Designed the Old Breda and St. Hedwig Church in Opava Renowned throughout Austria-Hungary
