Opava

is a statutory town in the Opava district in the Moravian-Silesian Region. It is located in the Opava Hills on the Opava River and has approximately 55,000 inhabitants, making it the third largest city in the Moravian-Silesian Region after Ostrava and Havířov. It was originally the center of the Principality of Opava and between 1742 and 1918 the capital of the Austrian, or of Czech Silesia with regional authorities.



Sights

- Silesian Museum

Oldest and third largest museum in CR

- Das Schloss Hradec nad Moravicí

Complex of heritage buildings
there are two circuits here

- Lookout tower Cvilín

It is a stone lookout tower, 28 m high, with a view of Krnov
and surroundings

- Arboretum Nový Dvůr

Dendrology garden, includes 7000 plantspecies
The most known is a collection of rhododendron plant family

- Hláška Opava

Town hall, residence of the Opava city council
The town hall's tower is accessible by stairs and
leads to a clerestory with a breathtaking view

- National memorial of the World War II., Hrabyně

Expositions: Age of downfall and hope, Cities in ruins,
Victims and murderers
